

This document contains a comprehensive listing of all available grant opportunities. Please carefully review each grant's details. **This year, grant applications will be considered on a rolling basis, so applying earlier can be advantageous.**

For any opportunities you select, it is imperative that your organization be capable of fulfilling the group size and scheduling requirements. Select members of your group will be required to attend a training session sometime between May and mid-June.

Some grant opportunities require a time commitment of 10 to 12 hours. While an organization's Team Leaders are required to be present for the duration of the scheduled commitment, a group's volunteer/member staff may break the work into two shifts, with the exception of select events.

All of your organization's team members must be 18 years of age or older although certain events require team members to be 21 years of age or older due to the presence of alcohol.
